

TEAMS AUTOMATICALLY RECLASSIFIED BY THE USSSA BY-LAWS FOR 2012

(December 1, 2011)

***PLEASE NOTE:** Teams required to compete at a higher classification in 2012 by the USSSA By-Laws that may be inadvertently omitted from the list below are not exempt from being reclassified.*

AUTOMATIC MOVE UP OF 2011 USSSA MEN'S CLASS "B" TEAMS:

The USSSA Slow Pitch By-Laws require that the winner of the 2011 Men's Class "B" World Tournament, and the winner of each 2011 Men's Class "B" National Tournament with 25 or more teams, will be automatically required to compete in a higher classification in 2012.

AUTOMATIC MOVE UP OF 2011 USSSA MEN'S CLASS "C" TEAMS:

The USSSA Slow Pitch By-Laws require that the top 10 percent of the finishing teams in the 2011 Men's Class "C" World Tournament (this includes teams that are tied with teams finishing in the top 10 percent in order of their finish; all percentages are rounded up), and the winner of each 2011 Men's Class "C" National Tournament with 25 or more teams, will be automatically required to compete in a higher classification in 2012. The USSSA Slow Pitch By-Laws require that the winner of the 2011 Women's Class "B" National or World Tournaments with 25 or more teams will automatically be required to compete as a Class "A" team in 2012.

AUTOMATIC MOVE UP OF 2011 USSSA WOMEN'S CLASS "C" TEAMS:

The USSSA Slow Pitch By-Laws require that the winner of the 2011 Women's Class "C" National or World Tournaments with 25 or more teams will automatically be required to compete as a Class "B" team in 2012. The team affected by this by-law is as follows:
